

Membership Eligibility and Joining the RSL

The following persons are eligible to join the RSL

- Any person who has served in any of the Australian Defence Forces in either of the two World Wars or in any theatre of conflict.
- Any person who has served for not less than six months in the Regular or Reserve Forces of the ADF, or of any country not an enemy of Australia. Shorter service can also qualify if discharge was honourable and for reasons beyond the individual's control.
- Any Australian citizen who has served overseas for not less than six months as a member of an approved Peacekeeping force.
- Any Australian or allied citizen who served with or in support of the ADF or Allied Forces in any theatre of conflict or during World War II, as a member of the Australian Women's Land Army or a Voluntary Aid Detachment in a Military or Convalescent Hospital.

If you wish to join the RSL you will need to complete an application form, you can download a copy or email a request to the Secretary of Engadine RSL Sub-Branch at engadinesb@gmail.com who will mail you out a copy.

You will be required to provide proof of your qualifying service when you submit your application, (Usually a certified copy of your Discharge Certificate or Statement of Service).

You may wish to attend in person with your application and supporting documents at any of our General Meetings which commence at 8.00pm on the 1st Monday of the Month from February to December, or leave a message on the Sub Branch answering machine 02 9548 5106 with your contact details, and the Secretary will arrange an appointment to attend the office.

If you attend in person at a meeting the Sub Branch Executive will be able to sight your documents on the night and put your application for approval to the members of the Sub Branch at the meeting on the same night.
